"RST Mobile Seminars" Project, Academy of Science, Fiscal Year 2023: Prevention of Parkinson's Disease: A Dream or a Reality?









The Academy of Science, Royal Society of Thailand (RST), collaborated with the Center of Excellence for Parkinson's Disease and Related Disorders, Chulalongkorn Hospital (or ChulaPD), Thai Red Cross Society, led by Professor Dr. Roongroj Bhidayasiri, M.D., both an RST Associate Fellow of the Academy of Science, and the Chair of ChulaPD, along with the Faculty of Medicine of Chulalongkorn University. organized academic conference on the theme "Prevention of Parkinson's Disease: A Dream or a Reality?" on July 7, 2023, from 8.30 to 16.30 at the Royal Princess Hotel, Larn Luang. Online attendance was available for anyone interested in this subject. The introductory remarks were given by Prof. Emeritus Surapol Issaragrisil, M.D., President of the RST. Speakers included RST Fellows and Associate Fellows from the Academy of Science, medical professionals specializing Parkinson's disease. technology specialists, Parkinson's disease patients. Knowledge, medical technology, and preventative guidelines were discussed at this meeting to promote greater comprehension. The subjects covered include the disease's prevalence in Thailand, its risk factors, and suggestions for preventing it through altering daily habits with an emphasis on eating right, exercising regularly, and getting enough sleeping that potentially exert impacts on the brain health. In addition, the use of digital technology will enhance diagnosis

precision and help identify people with early, mild symptoms who need rapid care. The Q&A session was designed to get the conference goers involved.

This academic conference had a total of 7,225 people registered, consisting of RST Fellows, RST Associate Fellows, medical professionals, Parkinson's sufferers, the media, and interested individuals. The event featured additional activities including a Parkinson's disease patient screening demonstration using digital technology, Thai-Mediterranean food demos, advice for exercise, and quality sleep for brain health. The event received substantial attention from attendees and the media. The attendees can benefit from the knowledge disseminated, especially from case studies and direct patient experiences. This body of knowledge will raise awareness of Parkinson's disease in Thai society and can help people better comprehend the illness and its symptoms.

During this key transition time, Thailand must accelerate the development of learning curricula to equip the Thai populace with AI Literacy. Therefore, a seminar on "The AI era has arrived: Is Thailand ready to deal with it?" was organized in conjunction with the School of Integrated Innovation, Chulalongkorn University on Friday, July 21, 2023, from 12.30 to 16.30 in Meeting Room 801 of the Chaloem Rajakumari 60th Anniversary Building, Chulalongkorn University. The event sought to bring together leading AI specialists in Thailand to brainstorm and compile a range of topics that will urge the government to take action to keep up with the current advancements.

Prof. Emeritus Worasak Kanoknukulchai, Ph.D., and Prof. Chayan Picheansoonthon, Pharm.D., Ph.D., Chairperson of the Academy of Science, were in charge of this academic discussion. In his introductory comments, Prof. Emeritus Surapol Issaragrisil, M.D., President of the RST, described the background and development of AI technology as well as the necessity of brainstorming AI experts in Thailand to assist those working in the government sector in developing strategies to deal with AI.
