The Royal Society of Thailand organized the *Royal Society of Thailand Tribute Project*, comprising an academic forum entitled “*Venerable Fellows of the Royal Society: Scholars of the Nation (14th Edition)*”, together with a forum and brainstorming session on *The Royal Society of Thailand’s Five-Year Strategy (Third Session)*. The event was held on Wednesday and Thursday, December 24-25, 2025, from 08.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m., at the Royal Princess Larn Luang Hotel, Larn Luang Road, Pom Prap Sattru Phai District, Bangkok.





The objectives of the project were to honor and disseminate the distinguished achievements and contributions of three venerable Fellows of the Royal Society:

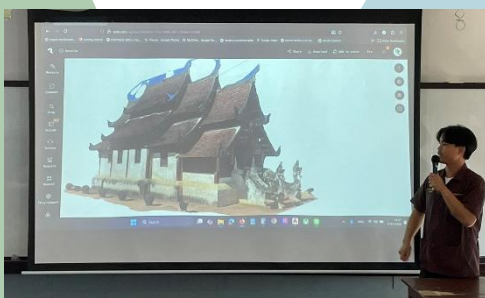
1. **Prof. Dr. Witt Siwasariyanon**, Fellow, Academy of Moral and Political Sciences

In addition, the event aimed to gather collective input to support the formulation of the **Royal Society of Thailand's Five-Year Strategy (Third Session)**, organized in conjunction with the **Centenary of the Royal Society of Thailand**. The outcomes of the discussions will be synthesized into a **master plan** to guide the development of an **action plan** and to support the preparation of **five-year budget proposals** for both the Royal Society of Thailand and the Office of the Royal Society of Thailand.

Royal Society Mobile Lecture “Ancient Lanna Architecture: Geometric Relationships and Structural Engineering Principles”



Through the **Academy of Arts**, the Royal Society of Thailand, organized a Royal Society Mobile Lecture entitled “*Ancient Lanna Architecture: Geometric Relationships and Structural Engineering Principles*”. The event was held at **Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna**, Chiang Mai Province, from **Thursday to Sunday, December 4-7, 2025**. The lectures were delivered by Fellows and Associate Fellows of the Academy of Arts, namely: **Asst. Prof. Dr. Chirapat Prapandvidya**, Fellow of the Royal Society; **Prof. Vacharee Svamivastu**, Associate Fellow; and **Assoc. Prof. Dr. Somchok Sinnukul**, Associate Fellow. The program was conducted in collaboration with faculty members from **Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna** and **Chiang Mai University**. More than **70 participants**, including faculty members and students, attended the event. Participants engaged in academic lectures as well as hands-on practical sessions conducted in both fieldwork and laboratory settings. Evaluation results indicated that the majority of participants reported a very high level of overall satisfaction.
